## Jacks' Flies of the month

- Jan. 6th;** CDC Enhanced Pink Squirrel: The pink squirrel nymph has become very popular as one of the best go to flies in S.W. Wisconsin streams, along with other bodies of water. The CDC (the fluff feathers from ducks) not only enhances the flies effectiveness, but holds small air bubbles that gives the fly more of a natural appearance. Be sure to tie them in the smaller sizes. Stand by!!!
- Jan. 13th;** Olive X Caddis: Craig Mathew (1983) is the fly's originator. The trailing zelon shuck gives the caddis a special fish appealing sparkle and liveliness. On many streams and waters, the caddis is the main food source so it's importance can't be overlooked by the fly fisherman.
- Jan. 20th;** Parachute Adams: A perfect mayfly imitation that is very irresistible in the water with the white calf tail upwing. The parachute, tied horizontal hackle improves the fly's floatability. The Adams Dry Fly is said at times to be the number one dry fly.
- Jan. 27th;** Tonight our guest speaker is Pat Ehlers. Pat is the owner of "The Fly Fisher" in Milwaukee, WI. Pat will demonstrate his fly tying style and tie some of his favorite pat terns. Come one, come all and let's welcome Pat for this special fly tying session. **SEE YOU THERE!!!** (the fly to be tied on 1-27-15, AK Quill..... will be tied on 2-3-15).

Racine harbor has been better with fish being caught off the docks since the ice is not safe. Most fish are being caught on small shiners or Moonshine Shiver Minnows.
