The Annual Pike River Revival is another huge success! By Jim Zondlak

The annual Pike River event was a total success. The day started with cold, wind and rain but by 9am the weather cleared and volunteers showed up to help do anything they could do to help. We collected 25 tires 12, 55 gallon bags of just 2 liter plastic bottles, hard drives, metal, lawn mower, plastic visqueen and that was about 200lbs. Bridgestone Firestone partnered with us and they picked up the tires to be recycled to what ever they determined. We had trout unlimited partner with us on 2 very large log jams west of the golf course, Andy Stowe worked with an area landowner to remove another large log jam near the railroad tressel south of highway E and the owner donated his equipment, time and it was a full day of work.

We had a total of 50 volunteers and everyone was treated to Water, Hotdogs, Brats, Chips, Cookies and Pizza. Everyone was positive and glad to help and a lot of attention was given through the local media. I have to thank all the club members that helped out in all areas from picking up trash, to taking food out to the volunteers. Rearing pond exit pipe has been replaced, we're ready for spring stocking!

The job of replacing the 12 inch galvanized exit pipe was a greater undertaking than originally expected. Mark Marano supplied his backhoes to do the excavation.

In August a 60 foot section of the old pipe was removed due to serious deterioration of the pipe on its lower section.

The decision was made to start excavation at the pond fence to determine how bad that end of the pipe was. It was discovered that the galvanized pipe went under the concrete walk, so it was removed. Then the first surprise became apparent. The galvanized 12-inch pipe was terminated 2 inches inside the 8-inch wall of the exit box. With no compressed air available it was unlikely that a connection of the new 8 inch PVC to the steel pipe enclosed in the wall. Ed St. Peter of the Water Dept. solved this problem by making a 6-inch adapter to fit the steel pipe and attach a 6-inch to 8-inch adaptor

to it. So the first day got us only 4 feet of pipe in the trench.

It had been decided that a 45-degree elbow would be used to reduce the path to the river by 30 feet. Saturday AM we started to excavate the run for the new pipe. It was a bit difficult to trench at the river's edge and our pro equipment operator Dave Aggazzi handled that chore. The pipe was set in the trench and pitched down hill. This took most of Saturday AM and PM.

Two slabs of concrete were placed under the new pipe at river's edge to support it. The trench was then backfilled and graded.

Lee Plumbing, who is selling it to us at his cost, supplied the pipe.

Thanks to all of the following for their invaluable assistance in get-



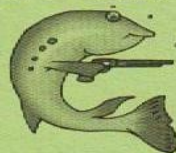
