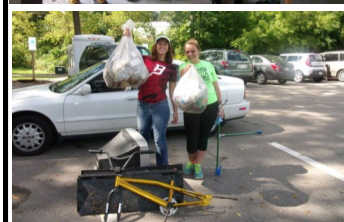

## **Annual PIKE RIVER CLEAN-UP was Sept. 17, 2016**

Somers- Deep in the UW Parkside woods, chainsaws growled into action on the Pike River Saturday, Sept. 17th. With determination, the eight-person crew, mostly wearing high wading boots, worked to clear a log jam, the result of a large tree that had fallen into the river.

### Fallen trees stop flow

The group was one of about 20 crews working on 25 log and brush jams on the river between Alford Park and Hawthorne Hollow for the annual Pike River Cleanup.

"There's been worse years," said Jim Zondlak of the KSFCA, which sponsors the cleanup. "The jams are natural occurrences. Mother Nature does not help herself out, but we are just assisting her."

Zondlak explained that removing the log jams helps lessen shore erosion. The better the flow, the fewer trees will fall from the banks into the river, he said.

The annual event started with a partnership between the nonprofit KSFCA, Kenosha County Parks Department, Root-Pike Watershed Initiative Network, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and the American Rivers organization. The KSFCA has been the driving force in the annual cleanup for about seven years, but the effort has roots going back 20 years. It draws 50 to 60 volunteers each year.

Shore fishing from Waukegan to Milwaukee is very good. Kings are making up most of the catches with occasional coho and brown trout. The best baits have been Flicker shad or salmon roe floated under a bobber. Off-shore fishing remains good as well. Most fish are being caught in 140 feet of water or deeper. Big lake trout are being caught along with some good catches of steelhead and coho. Dodgers and Spin-N-Glows run on downriggers have been best lately.

Fly fishing affects people in different ways. It can be an addiction; it can be a challenge; or it can be a reward. The fish will let you know if you are successful!

You can have somewhat creative freedom and add your personal touch to proven fly patterns. The creation of something truly unique and innovative is possible.

No matter what you take from fly tying, you can see what it takes to construct a fly, (different technical skills, materials, and management of thread). In the long run this makes you a better angler.

It is fun making something useful with your own hands. You take pride in your workmanship and skill. The learning of new skills is unsurpassed from learning in a fly tying class with fly tyers of different skill levels.

The flies to be tied in October are as follows:

Oct. 18th: Kenosha Candy— A very small wooly bugger configuration will be our first fly of the tying season starting Oct. 18th. The brown trout and smallmouth bass love this presentation. This might be the go-to-fly you'll need in your fly box, especially for the bluegill.

Oct. 25th: Faux Bugger— Trout and bass love this fly for obvious reasons. Gilt Eyelash yarn sparkles and shines in the water and pulsates when retrieved. Along with marabou as a tailing material, the action is fish catching, which is why this fly will delight the fly fisherman.

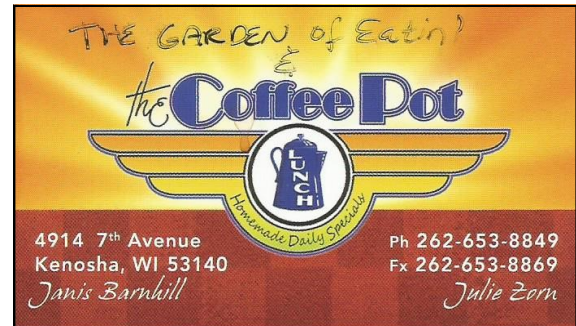

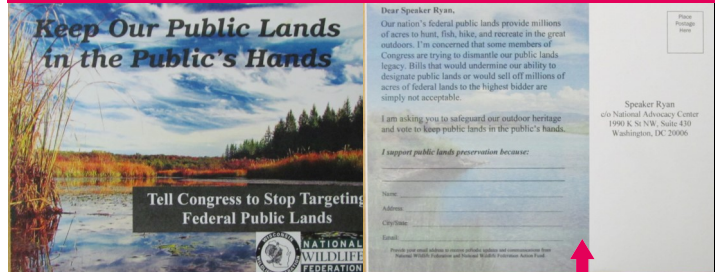


