The kings arrived in full force earlier this week. Catches between ten and twenty fish are reported in 120 to 150 feet of water. Chrome flashers like the Michigan Stinger, Dragon Lady and Super Frog with Aqua or Bullfrog Howie Flies are taking many big fish. Moonshine Blue Jackal, Happy Meal, and Dancing Anchovy are also getting a lot of bites on 250 ft. and 300 ft. coppers. It's great to see some good fishing, after a tough summer. Hopefully these fish stick around for a while.

Lake Michigan Outdoor Fishing Report –August 19th, 2014, by WDNR Kenosha Co.

- * Ramp: In Kenosha fishing was the same as Racine little to no action was reported from both shore and boat anglers, those that did catch fish were trolling in 100-150 feet of water using spoons and downriggers or lead core, most fish caught were small browns or chinooks. Colder water near shore is needed to help fishing in both ports.
- * Shoreline: Harbor fishing for browns slowed over the weekend due to east winds and warm water. Only a few browns were taken near the rocks by the hotel early or late in the day, best baits were spoons or jigs and plastics worked near the bottom.
- * Piers: High winds and warm water near shore made fishing difficult over the weekend and there were no reports of any fish other than a few gobies or rock bass being caught off of both the north and south piers.
