# Fly Fishing, the ultimate sport-fishing challenge

So is your fishing heating up like the weather and the water this year. Yes, the Brewers are improving, the Packers are waiting in the wings, and the Summer Olympics are right around the corner. The fishing is getting better and better. The couch will be there in the winter along with the potatoes on it. Make this summer your gold medal year.

The slight whisper of the fly line going through the fly rod eyelets, and that feather light cast with that custom fly you tied last winter (at the Moose) will definitely get that fish for you. Fly fishing is lovely to watch, and very relaxing in its execution.

Fly fisherman experience sights, sounds, and scenery not experienced by most people; for most people are not fly fisherman. We are the privileged few and we know it. Our fishing and hunting rights carry responsibilities, and nothing can be taken for granted. We collect the litter, police the streams and rivers, close the gates, get permission to cross private prop-

erty, leave no trace of our presence, and have the utmost respect of the environment. Fly fisherman need to be environmentalists for they explore and understand the natural world, and especially aquatic entomology. We are always looking for that bug . . . yes, you can go buggy also!

This is fly casting in a nutshell; the key to successful fly casting is tackle that is in perfect balance with itself. The fly line must complement the fly rod exactly. On the rod, by the top of the cork handle is the designation of rod length and weight. For example, a five weight fly rod accepts a five weight fly line for the very best balance possible. The fly reel should be of a compatible weight and size for the fly rod. Your leader should not be overly long and should not fall on itself when cast, but should be of the correct diameter for the fly your casting. The right balance of all the parts make for harmony and rhythm in the casting stroke.

You need to acquire the highest quality rod, reel, wad-

ers, fly lines, etc. that you can afford; if you don't you will live to regret it. Where do you start, and where do you end? Everyone wants superior quality at a reasonable price. There is a direct relationship between superior quality, top performance, and price. No one can tell you how much to spend on your tackle for fly fishing. The fishing catalogs are full of items to spend your money on; read them thoroughly and carefully. Comparison shopping at local area shops and at shopping malls can be helpful as is talking with fellow fly fishermen who will be willing to give you their opinions. Next month: the gear and why?

Fishing report for 7/31/12

Fishing remains to be good out of North Point. Salmon have been found in a wide variety of depth due to quick moving cold water but the most consistent fishing has been in 70 to 90 feet of water. Green, white, and chrome flashers with Glitter Bullfrog or Mirage Howie Flies in the bottom half of the water column are taking good numbers of kings. Early in the morning Warrior Ultra Glow Dirty Diaper and Blue Berry Muffin are catching a lot of fish. During the day UV Stinger PK Special, Blue Tux, and Dolphin are very effective.

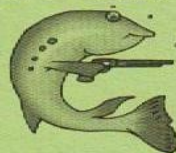
