ASIAN CARP GATE FIX TO BE DONE THIS MONTH

Milwaukee(AP) (article from the Kenosha News)

More than 200 state and federal workers will poison the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal early December to fight the spread of the Asian Carp to Lake Michigan.

The electric fish barrier blocking the canal needs maintenance, but before it can be shut down officials need to make sure the carp won't get passed it when the power os off.

John Rogner of the Illinois Department of Natural Resources says they'll do that with a two day, \$1.5 million project to poison nearly six miles of canal just southwest of Chicago. It's scheduled to start December 2nd.

The invasive Asian Carp have been detected within a mile of the barrier, which is about 20 miles downstream from the Lake Michigan shoreline.

Adirondack Salmon Chowder
From the Adirondack Series by Musky Bob

- Â· Â½ stick butter
- Â· Â¼ cup flour
- Â· Â½ cup chopped onion
- Â· 6 slices bacon, diced
- Â· Â½ cup diced celery
- Â· 1 Â½ teaspoons garlic powder not garlic salt
- Â· 1 tablespoon old bay seasoning
- Â· 1 Â½ cup diced potatoes
- Â· Â½ bag baby carrots, cut bite size
- Â· 1 cup chicken broth
- Â· 1 teaspoon salt
- Â· 1 teaspoon ground black pepper
- Â· 1 teaspoon parsley
- Â· 1 teaspoon dried dill weed
- Â· 2 6? salmon fillets, de-boned & cubed 1?
- Â· 1 qt. milk
- Â· 1 (15 ounce) can creamed corn
- Â· 1 teaspoon cornstarch
- Â· 1 12 oz. pkg. Cream cheese

1. Saute bacon, then add butter, onion, broth, celery, and garlic powder & cook until onions, carrots, and celery are tender. Stir in potatoes, old bay seasoning, parsley, salt, pepper, and dill.
2. Bring to a boil, and reduce heat. Cover, and simmer 20 minutes or until potatoes are tender.
3. Stir in salmon, milk, creamed corn, flour, cornstarch, and cream cheese. Cook on medium, stirring frequently until heated through.
