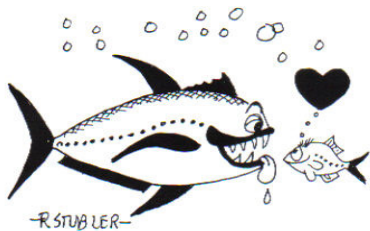

KSFCA Contest Rules

Monthly Contest

Angler must be a regular member of the Kenosha Sports Fishing and Conservation Association.

Angler must have joined the Association at least two days prior to entering a fish in any KSFCA sanctioned contest. Unless clearly specified otherwise.

All fish must be caught in Lake Michigan (as defined in DNR regulations)

Controversy shall be settled by the Contest Committee. The committee will act on any protest, filed in writing, by any KSFCA member and given to any member of the Contest committee. But will provide interpretations to a rule or controversy as information to the member. Resolution of a controversy is the decision of the Contest Committee, whose decision will be final.

All fish registered for Any KSFCA contest must be a minimum of 16" in length. All fish must be registered at Harborside Bait and Tackle. Monthly contest starts first of May and ends in September's end. Each month is a new month. Fish must be registered that month.

A fish may be held overnight for weigh-in the next day, provided that following day is in the same month.

Awards for the top three fish of each species will be awarded on the next month's meeting.

Points are awarded for the top three fish. Which is totaled at the end of the year and at that time, points are tabulated.

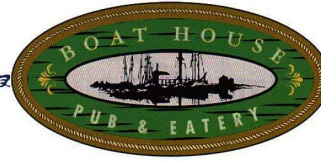
First = 5 points Second = 3 points Third = 2 points

Based on points, the winner receives the Phil Sanders Master Angler Award.

Rules may be changed once the contest committee has deemed necessary.

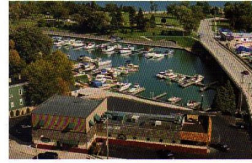
Monthly Outing Rules

- **5:30 A.M.** Start, entrants may call in no later than 6:00 A.M. over the marine radio on **channel 8**. 1/2 hr. start run time allowed.
- Members and non members must register at **Harborside Bait & Tackle Shop**.
- Contestants may use up to 9 rods per boat.
- Weigh in will be at **11.00 A.M.** at the fish cleaning station.
- Non member fee's will be \$30.00 and will include a membership for the remainder of the year. \$5.00 for Big Fish.
- Member's fee will be \$20.00 and \$5.00 for Big Fish.
- Total weight of 10 fish will be used to place.
- All Wisconsin regulations apply. Any citations issued by the Coast Guard or DNR will cause automatic disqualification.
- Prizes to be awarded at the KSFCA monthly meeting at the Moose Club.
- The club uses Marine channel 8.

Racine Barbecued Lake Trout

(Recipe from the GLA)

We received this recipe from a member of Salmon Unlimited of Wisconsin from Racine Wisconsin.

- 2 Lake Trout filets
- 4 tablespoons margine or butter
- 1 large Onion
- 1 cup Sweet Baby Rays Barbecue Sauce
- Aluminum Foil

Measure a doubled aluminum foil sheet large enough for the Lake Trout filets. You will need two large pieces, one for the top and one for the bottom. Rub the foil with margine. Cut the Onion into slices and place the separated rings on the aluminum foil. Place the Lake Trout filets on top of the onion. Pour the Barbecue Sauce on top of the filets. Place more onions on top of the filets. Place on top another piece of aluminum foil. Crimp the edges of the aluminum foil to enclose the filets. On a hot grill place the aluminum foil package. Grill for 5 minutes per side. Serves four.

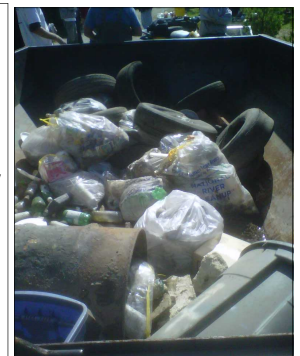

For all my friends that are waiting for the Salmon report....Here goes. The rain we received again this week was slight to say the least. Big storms that were supposed to hit....didn't.

The West winds and the little rain we did get managed to open the creek (Pike) enough to let the fish up it. Actually a few of our Central European friends shoveled it open last weekend, but it only lasted for a day or two. At this time, it has been open since Friday, and is still open today (Sunday). So I'm sure there are enough Kings in there to play with if that is your game.

Fishing in the harbor has been great at times, and lousy at times. If you happen to be there when they turn on, you can get them on just about everything. Again, for those of you that are newcomers we're talking about: Oslos-inline spinners with rubber skirts with different colored bodies and blades that plain kill the Salmonids, Cleos- one of the original casting spoons that come in different weights and colors most popular of which this time of year are glows and metallics in 3/4oz., K.O. wobblers available in the same colors as the Cleos, but with a different profile which gives them a different action in the water that- sometimes makes all the difference in the world, Krocodiles- another casting spoon that is heavy with a longer thinner profile (longer casting) that is available in more glow colors than the rest, Kastmasters- another heavy/thin spoon that is an old standby, Blue Fox Spinners- large sinners in blow colors with dressed hooks, Moonshine spoons- heavy, and glow like a flashlight, Rattletraps- a great water covering lipless crankbait that gets the fish's attention, Thunderstiks- made by Storm- long stickbaits that are available in every depth and some great glow and firetiger colors, Rapalas- old reliable- if you don't know what these are...I can't help you, and our own hand-tied spawn sacks- a mixture of trout and salmon eggs that we cure and tie in little mesh bags that you can impale on a hook available in pink, green and orange.

Others that merit mention- Play doh, we carry it. People say it really works. I have never used it, but that doesn't mean it doesn't work. And last but not least, Luckycraft crankbaits- very good colors, very good action, catch lots of fish, but at a price tag of \$20.00 (average) I have to say they don't really fly out of the store. But those that don't mind spending money on them swear they are the best for fish in the harbor.

Well, I meant to keep this short, but as usual it got away from me.

Inland- not much happening, most Delevan fishermen are waiting for the crappies to start biting. Haven't heard about Silver yet, but being a Muskie fisherman, I'd like to get out there and cast buck-tails on the flats. Geneva- heard they're getting gills in deep water (30+).

That's it for now.
