The KSFCA voted to donate \$200.00 to the Wisconsin Federal Great Lakes Sports Fishing Council. For sponsor travel expenses.

As of the beginning of August we have 97 members and 47 sponsor's.

Augusts' contest/fish fry went very well (see page (3). September 12th will be the final one for 2010. All members should at their best should attend at least one of these events. Friendly competition, good eats and conversations are priceless. Mingling with members and their families is at the premium. Members seeking fishing and boating information will find answers, or lead to who can assist. The monthly meeting will be on Sept. 13th, backed up a week for Labor day.

More than 800,000 gallons of oil into a southern Michigan river. Officials with Calgary, Alberta-based Enbridge Inc. made the announcement during an update on the spill, which coated birds and fish as it poured into a creek and flowed into the Kalamazoo River. "We've made significant progress," company CEO Patrick D. Daniel said. "But we still have a long way to go in terms of cleanup." The company had about 200 employees and contractors working on the spill on Tuesday. The Environmental Protection Agency also is bringing in additional contractors, and there was no update on a possible cause, cost or length of cleanup. "The longer oil is out there the more continued volatilization occurs and the more we become concerned about prolonged potential exposures," said Ralph Dollhopf of the EPA. He said EPA scientists are taking air and water samples. Health officials say the area is highly toxic and are advising people to stay away. All portions of the Kalamazoo River affected by the spill are closed to fishing, boating and swimming. Michigan Gov. Jennifer Granholm has declared a state of disaster in Calhoun County and some other affected areas along the river. Granholm toured the area by helicopter Tuesday night and said she wasn't satisfied with the response to the spill. The leak in the 30-inch pipeline, which was built in 1969 and carries about 8 million gallons of oil daily from Griffith, Ind., to Sarnia, Ontario, was detected early Monday.

# KSFCA Contest Rules

## Monthly Contest

Angler must be a regular member of the Kenosha Sports Fishing and Conservation Association.

Angler must have joined the Association at least two days prior to entering a fish in any KSFCA sanctioned contest. Unless clearly specified otherwise.

All fish must be caught in Lake Michigan (as defined in DNR regulations)

Controversy shall be settled by the Contest Committee. The committee will act on any protest, filed in writing, by any KSFCA member and given to any member of the Contest committee. But will provide interpretations to a rule or controversy as information to the member. Resolution of a controversy is the decision of the Contest Committee, whose decision will be final.

All fish registered for Any KSFCA contest must be a minimum of 16" in length. All fish must be registered at Harborside Bait and Tackle. Monthly contest starts first of May and ends in September's end. Each month is a new month. Fish must be registered that month.

A fish may be held overnight for weigh-in the next day, provided that following day is in the same month.

Awards for the top three fish of each species will be awarded on the next month's meeting.

Points are awarded for the top three fish. Which is totaled at the end of the year and at that time, points are tabulated.

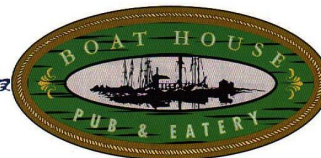
First = 5 points    Second = 3 points    Third = 2 points

**Rules may be changed once the contest committee has deemed necessary.**

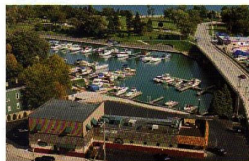
## Monthly Outing Rules

- Total weight of 10 fish will be used to place.
- All Wisconsin regulations apply. Any citations issued by the Coast Guard or DNR will cause automatic disqualification.

**Lake Michigan Brown Trout New State Record**  
**41.8 lb monster a sign of the great fishery**

It's official: the 41 lb.,8 oz. brown trout Roger Hellen of Franksville caught in Lake Michigan on July 16 is now a Wisconsin state record fish. And it may be a world record, too.

The DNR received Hellen's application shortly after he recorded his catch and has confirmed the new state record, which smashes the old record by nearly 5 lbs. The previous record was 36 lbs. 8.9 ounces and 40.5" for a fish caught August 23, 2004, in Lake Michigan.

Hellen's is the ninth state record set this year, and the first for a fish caught by hook and line. The other records have been for fish taken using alternate methods, including a spearing record for lake sturgeon and six bowfishing records. One of those bowfishing records, for smallmouth buffalo, was first established in March and has changed hands twice since, once in April and again on July 1.

Hellen caught the fish in Lake Michigan north of Racine while competing in a fishing tournament. The fish measured 40.6 inches long and weighed 41 pounds 8 ounces on a certified scale at a local meat market, according to Cheryl Peterson, the state fisheries technician who weighed, measured and processed the fish at the tournament.

With that certified weight, Hellen's fish would appear to squeak by the 41 lb. 7 oz. world record brown trout caught last year in the Big Manistee River in Michigan.

"It was very exciting – it was certainly the biggest trout or salmon I've ever seen," says Peterson, a fish technician on Lake Michigan since 1997. "We knew as soon as it was on the scale it was going to be a new state record." The lure was a blue-and-green spoon trolled about 10' below the surface.

Hellen's brown was weighed on a certified scale at Brossman's Meat Market while being witnessed by three butchers (with at least 23 years of experience each), Hellen and a Salmon-A-Rama official. "They [first] went to a meat market down the road," butcher Jeff Luzich said. "They didn't have a scale big enough."

"I've fished out on Lake Michigan and caught browns of 10-15 pounds, [but nothing like that]," Hellen said. "It was a beautiful fish." "This is great for the lake, great for the club, great for the fishery," said Tom Pietila, president of Salmon Unlimited of Wisconsin.

All bites are steady except for the perch fishing from shore. Boat action has been good for perch. If not at the bubbler which is good 90% of the time, then people drift over to the old piers that stick out into the water south of the Southport Beachhouse. You have to be careful around those piers. There lots of snags and lot of places to ding a prop. Not as much action coming from the break water. Shore Fishing has been spotty be-

cause of no steady winds, but guys who brave a broken ankle are doing well from the rocks that surround the marina, and at the end of 75th st. Also, some guys fish those same piers mentioned above from shore, but it is not easy.

As of today the best off-shore action has been in about 160ft. of water, and half way down. Mixed bags are coming in with a few four year old Chinooks. Lots of leadcore activity- very few fish have been taken off of downriggers this year.

Delavan- I personally got to finally take part in the "Great Bluegill Slaughter". I took Brandon and his daughter Kaley out there about a week ago and the two of them killed the fish. Kaley was catching doubles and it took everything she had to reel them in on my 4.5 ft. ultralight St.Croix. "It's too tough, Bob", she kept saying and I told her to just take her time and keep reeling. She was plenty wore out, and I bet her she'd fall asleep on the way home. She and her dad were at my house at 4:15, which is real early for a seven year old. My favorite part was when she dogged her old man. He was holding up questionable fish, and was asking me if I thought they qualified as "Kenosha Keepers"\*. I would say either yes or no, and Kayli was taking this in, and when she caught a real fat 8 1/2 incher she exclaimed, "now that's a Kenosha Keeper!" Her dad and I laughed our butts off.

The following evening I took my mom and my father-in-law out there, and eventhough it was drizzling on us they were both catching doubles as fast as they could get it back in the water. We left at 7:30, but not because the fish stopped biting.

Here is where I should probably comment on the amount of boats that are continually pulling limits of fish out of that lake. The first time we went we were leaving the launch at about 5:15 a.m. and all the parking spaces on the gravel were full. When we got back, (we had the boat completely tied down by 10:00) every spot was full on the grass as well. Old timers you see brag about how they got their limit again. What can you do with all those fish? I gave Brandon all the ones we caught. The total came to a little over 40. Which is about thirty more than I want to clean. When the three of us went out the next night I kept 18 of the best ones and that was too many as far as I was concerned. Do the math. Two or three guys in a boat catching 50 to 75 fish a day times probably an easy 200 to 300 boats a day times probably 45 to 60 days that the real big bite is on. That comes to minimally- 450,000 fish. Wow that's the first time I ever saw it in print. If you go the max. route that's 1,350,000 fish a season. What a fishery! Nothing lasts forever my friends. I don't know of any lake that can keep up those numbers for long. Those of us who fish there every year have seen a steady decline in the size of the good fish. When Dave and I first started 9 inchers were normal, the next year they were harder to come by. Then 8 1/2 inchers got harder to find. Now if you're pulling in 8's steadily you are lucky. You can't tell people to take it easy. They just don't. So be ready for it all to end soon. I guess the best thing is to get as many as your conscience allows while you can.

### Spiders on your boat?

Did some surfing on ridding spider's on boats. As you can guess many defend the spiders existence. Yea they do help keep bugs to a minimum. However the clean up is tedious. The following is what I have noticed repeated often on the hundreds of "hits". Sorry to say but between electronic devices and chemical's mentioned. Non seem all that promising but numbers may diminish.

I tried to list ones that would not effect fishing tackle, scent wise. Many of you may have already tried some of these but just wanted to mention them for people who have not.

Get rid of pesky cobwebs and discourage their reformation with Dr. T's Cobweb Eliminator. Dr. T's unique cobweb eliminator formula derived of 100% natural ingredients can be used anywhere cobwebs are noticed, without staining or any lasting odors. Shake well and direct nozzle to completely wet the problem area. Remove debris with a stiff-bristle broom. A residue will be left behind which prevent spiders from reforming their webs in the same location. Reapply as necessary. One treatment lasts 6 months indoors and 2 to 3 months outdoors. Cobweb Eliminator may be applied to wood, painted surfaces, vinyl, fiberglass, concrete and masonry. 32 Fl. Oz.

 "I learned this from the man who trained the spiders for the movie *Arachnophobia*. Spiders have their taste buds on the tips of their legs. They also hate the taste of lemon pledge. Dust your windowsills and doorframes with the pledge, both inside and out, and any areas where they accumulate. The spiders will find that they don't want to live with you."

You can deter all spiders with conkers, the chestnut wood deters them as its bitter. this was discovered when it was noticed that spiders did not spin webs in chestnut roof timbers. place them in the corners of the room and on window sills. since we've done this we've only had the tiddly ones.
