

2019 KSFCA Tournament Rules

Tournament Chair: Mike Williams 312-969-4544

→ Boat Division

- ◆ Sign-ups will be at the KSFCA general monthly meeting prior to the tournament weekend. Sign-up by phone no later than 48 hours prior to the start time. NO LAST MINUTE PHONE SIGN-UPS. Entry fee of \$25 per team must be received at monthly meeting. Big fish contest is \$10 per team also due at monthly meeting. Teams will receive a catch sheet at sign-up.
- Start time is an open start no earlier than 5:00 am.
- ◆ Teams may use up to 9 rods.
- ◆ All Wisconsin fishing regulations apply.
- ◆ Teams may enter 10 fish total which only four can be lake trout.
- ◆ All teams must have cooler in line for weigh in no later than 11:30 am with catch sheet completed and signed by captain.
- ◆ An additional 10 points is awarded to a boat with a new member or a member who does not own a boat. A new member is defined as someone who has joined the club in the last year. A boat will only receive 10 bonus points once per year per new member or member without a boat.
- Points will be awarded as follows for;
 - 25 points per species
 - 10 points per fish.
 - 1 point per pound.
- Payout will be for the top three weight totals and largest fish of any species.
- ◆ Points from each monthly tournament, both boat and shoreline, will accumulate and a KSFCA tournament season champion will be awarded at the end of season awards banquet. An award will be given for boat and shore divisions.
- ◆ All payouts will be awarded at the fish fry following the tournament.
- Charter boats are eligible to participate, but not eligible for the 10 bonus points.
- ◆ There will be a fish fry after every KSFCA tournament. Fresh trout and salmon along with member prepared sides and desserts, will be served at the pavilion above the cleaning station. All KSFCA members are invited even if not a tournament contestant. Great time to bring family, friends and any prospective members, or supporters.

→ Shoreline Division

- ◆ Start time is an open start no earlier than 4:00 am.
- ◆ 3 rods per person.
- Entry fee is \$10 per individual Biggest Fish takes all shoreline prize money.
